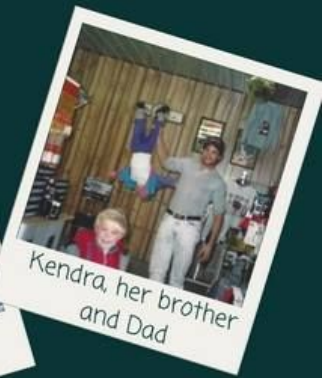



- income below 50% of the Area Median Income
